Per Curiam: James P. Klein appeals rulings of the Shawnee County District Court on motions related to the decree of divorce dissolving the marriage between him and Lori L. Klein. The motions relate to determination of his overtime income for purposes of calculating maintenance and child support, whether Lori Klein had entered into a marital-type relationship with another man thereby affecting her right to maintenance, and granting Lori Klein payment of \$2,538.32 in substitution for personal property awarded to her but either never delivered to her or delivered in damaged condition.

We have reviewed the briefs and the record, including the detailed findings and conclusion of the district court. We find no error.
